Subject pronouns; Present simple: form and use; positive, negative and interrogative forms; present simple of the verb to be (uses); short answers; there is/there are; present simple with adverbs of frequency; present simple of the verb to do: positive, negative, interrogative forms; short answers; genitive 's and s' (genitivo sassone); imperative; present continuous; present simple vs present continuous; past simple of to be; past simple of regular and main irregular verbs (for irregular verbs see list given p. 220): positive, negative and interrogative forms; short answers; past continuous; past continuous v past simple; present perfect simple: use and formation; present perfect with adverbs of frequency: always, often, ever, never, just, already, still, yet; present perfect with so far, up to now, this is the first/second time that....; been v gone; present perfect simple with "how long...?" and with since/for; present perfect v past simple; past continuous; past simple v past continuous; future tenses: present simple and present continuous [for future arrangements] ; will v might; will v be going to; present continuous; how to express ability : can/could/be able to, to express ability in the present, in the past, in the future; managed to; how to express obligation/necessity: must/have to; mustn't (for prohibition) / don't have to (to express lack of necessity); modal verbs for giving advice should/shouldn't.
